

Dental Composite

Dental Composite (Bonding) is another way your teeth can be repaired and your smile maximised.

About

Composite bonding is much more cost effective, versatile, and a less evasive alternative to porcelain veneers. They serve the same purpose, but instead of a porcelain veneer being attached, the tooth is reconstructed through a build up of the composite bonding material. It can be repaired, altered or re-done at any time.

If you have chipped teeth, gapped teeth and staining of both teeth and fillings, composite bonding is a solution for you. However if your smile is crooked because of problems with your bite and jawline, this treatment won't correct it.

The treatment usually begins with our dentist removing some surface enamel from your teeth, allowing us to best shape the composite bonding to your tooth. After this we will apply the bonding agent, add the bonding resin, cure it with a special light and finish by polishing your teeth.

It is a safe and effective technique that was developed more than 50 years ago, and has been widely available for over three decades.
